Year 7 Literacy and Numeracy Catch-up premium

Intended spend - 2018/19

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives schools additional funding to support year 7 students who did not achieve the expected standard in reading or mathematics at the end of key stage 2 (KS2). There are 46 students identified as being in need of support to achieve the expected standard in English with 13 identified as a high priority. 44 students are also in need of support to achieve the expected standard in maths with 12 being a high priority as well.

In 2018/19 the school is expected to receive £13,422 for the catch-up premium (based on 2017/2018 allocation)

This funding will be used to:

- Provide extra adult support in lower sets for English and mathematics lessons.
- Small group tuition for personalised support in literacy and numeracy.
- Provide support through the Chrysalis Learning Programme.
- Provide extra support through 1:1 tuition.
- Support year 6 to year 7 transition and summer school programme.
- Part of funding allocated to the Accelerated Reader program to improve literacy.

The expected impact will be for students in this group to make progress towards the expected standard in English and mathematics.
